'Important Questions' Evenings in October, January and February

Both regular churchgoers and those who avoid church have questions to wrestle with when it comes to the Christian faith. This coming church year there will be three evenings and one morning looking at some important questions, all with visiting speakers who are well equipped to help us wrestle with these questions.

Come and hear a survivor of the Rwandan Genocide, an Oxford Professor, an expert in ancient manuscripts and a theologian offer their thoughts before a time of Q&A. Come yourselves and bring your friends and family along as well as we ask these essential questions:



- 'Where was God when that happened?'
- 'What makes us human?'
- 'Has science buried God?'
- 'Can we trust the gospels?'





This Group will meet in various locations throughout the village on the last Friday or Saturday evening of each month, except December. Sometimes the evening will just be fellowship and fun: on other occasions there will be specific activities such as a music or quiz night.

Sunday Club involves a mix of Bible teaching, games, craft activities, discussion, quizzes, singing and drama. We hope that the children will make good friends and grow in their understanding of faith in Jesus Christ.

Pathfinders (Year 5-Year 11)


Pathfinders is all about enjoying time together and getting to know God better. We catch up, play games and dive into the Bible to see what it's got to say to us and our daily lives.
